A Note from Pastor Brendan...

I am amazed at how God is on the move these days! The “God Moment” conversations I’ve had with people recently clearly speak to God’s desire to work in new ways through the Church to bless our community. Sometimes throughout life it’s easy to get stuck in a rut mentality. Some of our best ideas are still waiting for the right moment. We call it preparation. However, many times it's really procrastination. Eventually the due diligence phase yields to the do-nothing phase. And another good idea gets covered in cobwebs.

Keep in mind what William Feather said: **"Conditions are never just right. People who delay action until all factors are favorable do nothing."** There’s something to be said for beginning now and filling in the details as you go. Not that details aren't important or that preparation isn't necessary, but at some point, you’ve got to quit compiling data and start pursuing results.

Do you know what the problem is? There’s no failure to face in the preparation stage. There’s no disappointment to deal with in the dream-casting stage. It’s only after the plan has been put into practice that you confront results that maybe don’t meet expectations. It’s easy to get nervous. It’s easier to plan just a little longer. When Abraham was older than just about everyone who will be reading these words, God told him, ***"Leave your country, your people, and your father's household and go to the land I will show you."*** (Genesis 12:1)

Abraham went, not having a plan in place, not knowing exactly what lay ahead, only that he was following the voice of God. There are times when it’s time to do just what Abraham did: take the first few steps, even if all the questions haven’t been answered and all the problems aren’t solved in advance.

As we move into the fall season, I don’t claim to know where God is leading you, but I want to encourage you to prayerfully ask the question, “Is now the time?” Rather than become stuck saying, “Someday, I’ll serve,” “Someday, I’ll do this or that,” let’s prayerfully determine to take that next faithful step.

There's something to be said for beginning now.

STEWARDSHIP UPDATE

Thank you for your generous giving towards Forward in Faith, which enables the church to save for future capital expenses vs going into debt.

The Trustees have identified the following projects need to be completed:

- **Replacing the front walkway and handicap access to the entry of the church**
- **Painting the HUB**
- **Installing electric in the new shed**

The estimated cost of completing all of these projects is \$62k. The Stewardship Committee, Finance Committee, and Admin Council have all approved the use of Forward in Faith funds. Thanks to your generous giving, we have approximately \$90k in Forward in Faith savings which is more than enough to fund these projects. The work is expected to begin this Fall.

As we spend the funds, the total Forward in Faith savings number will be updated in the bulletin.
