### Springing Forward in Faith: Celebrating Resurrection and Renewal

This Easter season, our hearts are overflowing with gratitude as we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ—a powerful reminder that God brings new life, hope, and transformation even after the darkest winters. Just as the earth awakens in spring, we see God stirring renewal in our hearts, in our community, and throughout our church family.

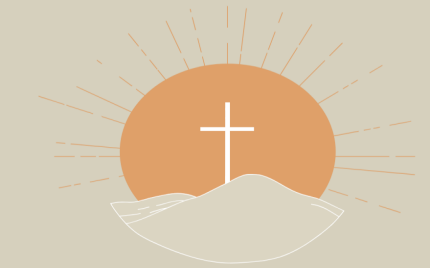
